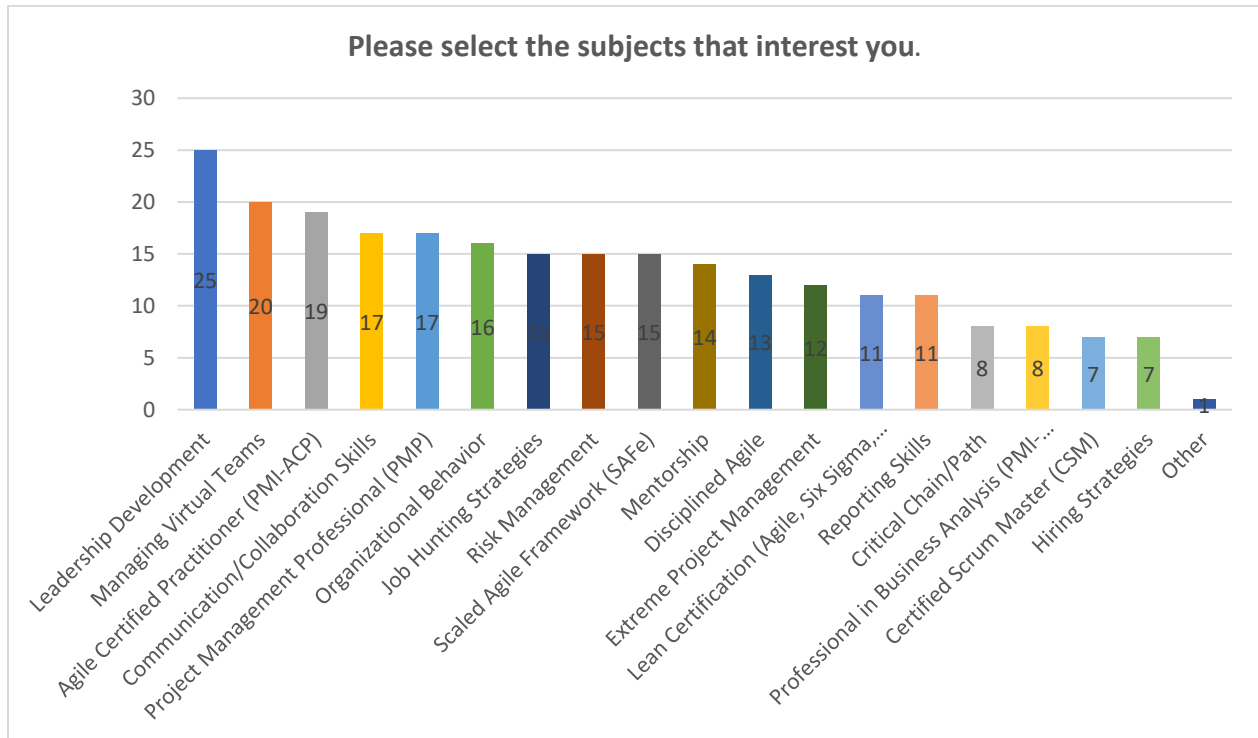
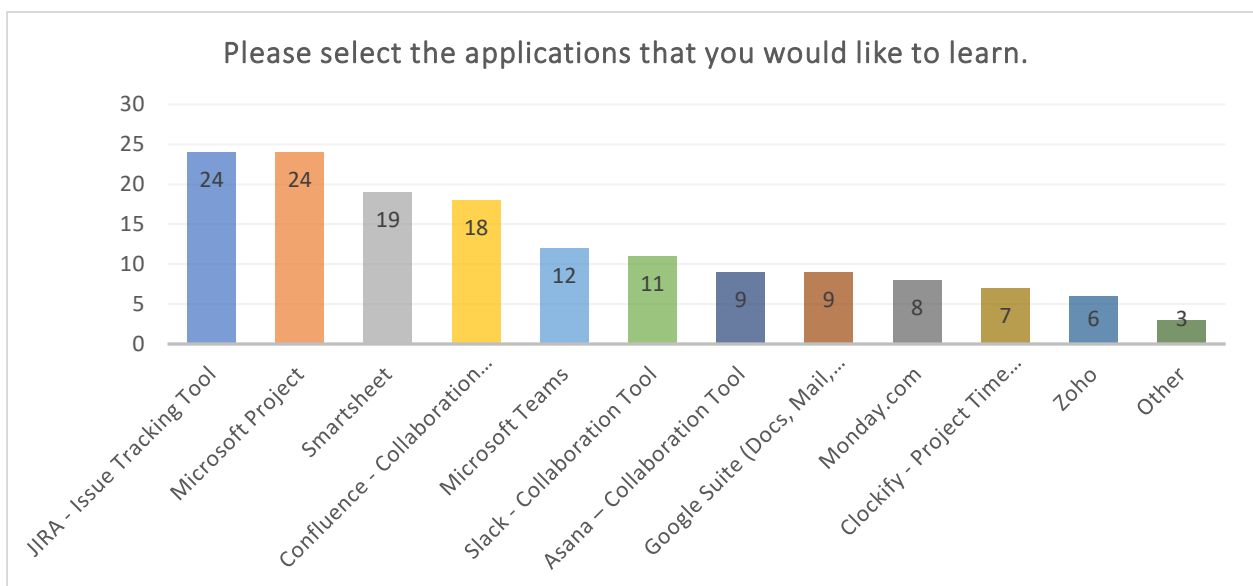


Project Management Institute-LA 2022 Career Development Survey Analysis

This report consists of five sections with each section corresponding to one of the five 2022 Career Development Survey questions with graphs showing the ranked responses. Each section also includes a brief analysis of the results. With 1,674 members surveyed there were 48 respondents. This provides a reliable 90% confidence level with a 12% margin of error.ⁱ While these numbers are not as strong indicators as last year's due to sample size, they still serve as the voice of our members.

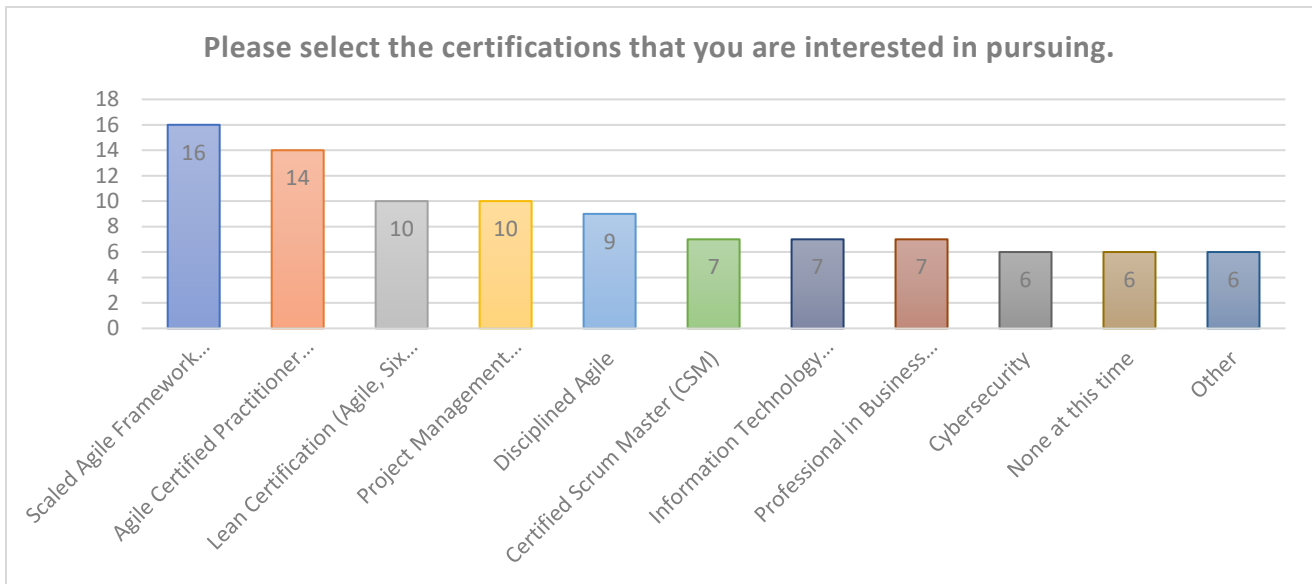


Soft skills such as, Leadership Development, Managing Virtual Teams, Agile Certified Practitioner, and Communication/Collaboration ranked ahead of the Project Management Professional (PMP). Career Development offered leadership, collaboration, managing virtual teams, and communication classes in 2021 and will continue to do so in 2022. Agile Certified Practitioner is not a new topic, but this is the highest ranking that it has achieved in the survey.

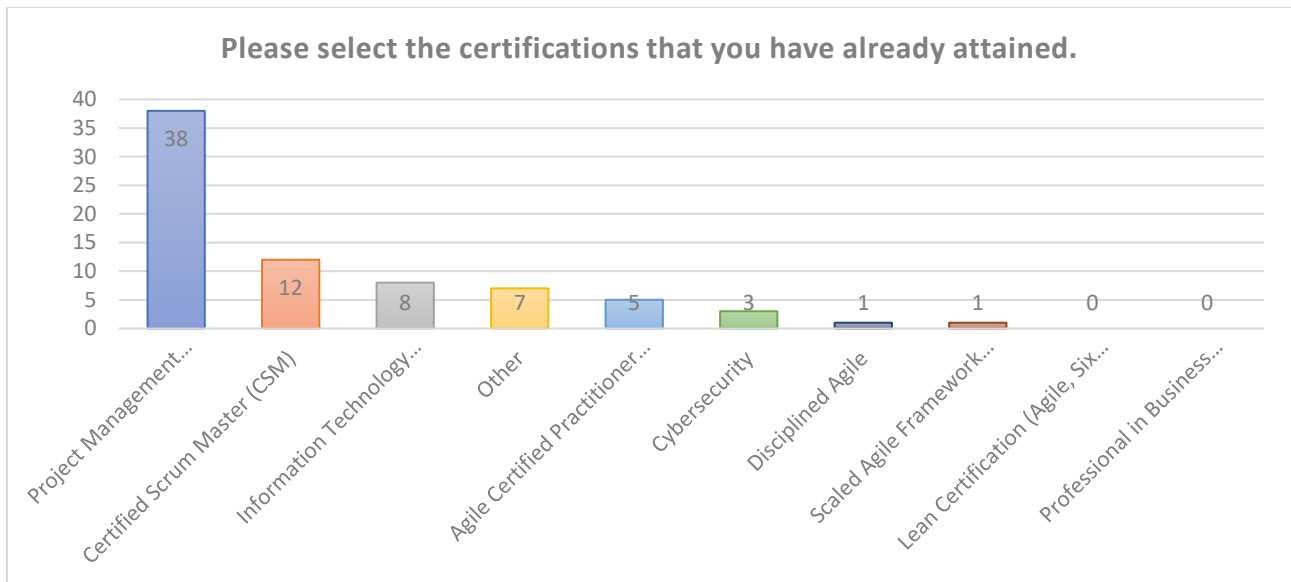


Both JIRA and Microsoft Project classes will be continued in 2022. Other courses will be offered depending on member demand and class availability.

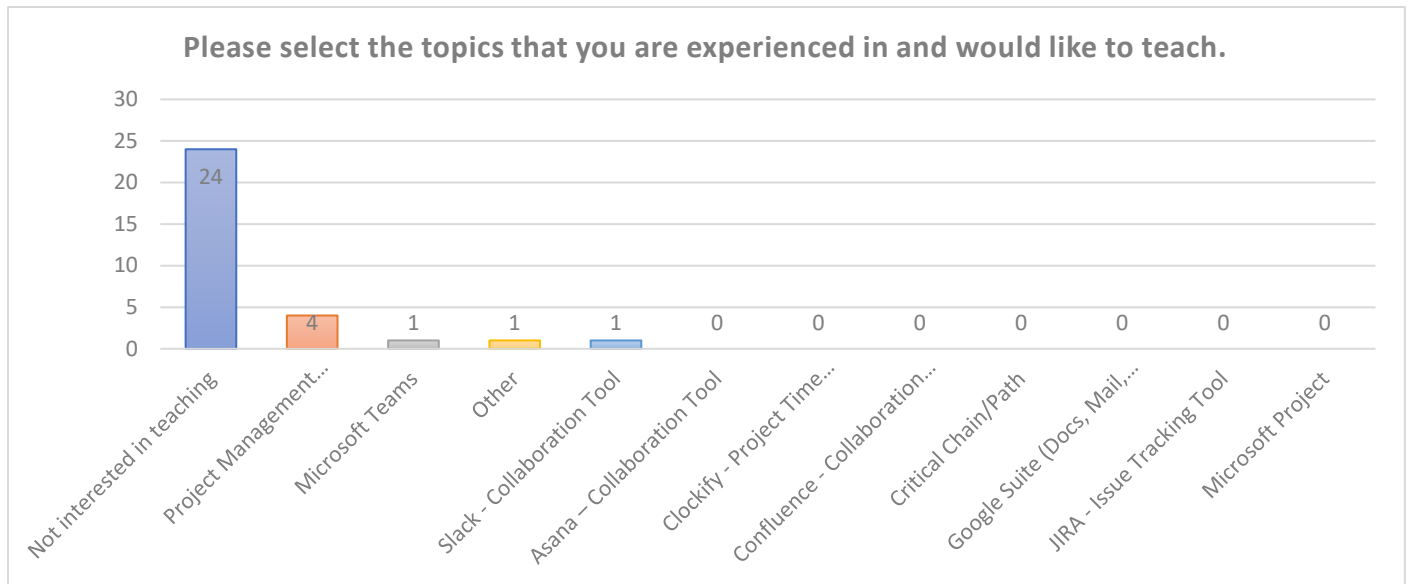


Scaled Agile Framework (SaFe) beat out the Project Management Professional (PMP), Agile Certified Practitioner, and Lean Certification for the certification that members would like to pursue. Therefore, an evaluation of SaFe trainers will be conducted for classes in 2022. Even though the current PMP exam heavily incorporates Agile components members have expressed interest in the standalone PMI-ACP certification which we plan to offer in 2022 as well.



Not surprisingly for a Project Management organization, the Project Management Professional (PMP) remain the leading certification, followed by the miscellaneous Certified Scrum Master (CSM) category. These two categories were trailed by various Agile certifications showing that respondents do **not currently possess** the Agile certifications.

Respondents have largely expressed no desire to teach. This remains as it was last year. This may be related to decreased available time due to demands from the COVID-19 pandemic. The high cost to certify as instructor under the new PMP training guidelines still serves as a deterrent to non-professional trainers looking to teach the PMP class.
