

## **Project Management Institute-LA 2023 Career Development Survey Analysis**

This report consists of five sections with each section corresponding to one of the five 2023 Career Development Survey questions with graphs showing the ranked responses. Each section also includes a brief analysis of the results. With 1,760 members surveyed there were 49 respondents. This provides a reliable 90% confidence level with a 12% margin of error.




Skills such as, Leadership Development, Communication/Collaboration, Job Hunting, and Reporting Skills ranked ahead of the Project Management Professional (PMP). Career Development offered the aforementioned classes as well as Managing Virtual Teams and Mentorship in 2022 and will continue to do so in 2023.




Microsoft Project, Smartsheet, and JIRA classes were scheduled during 2022 and will be again in 2023.




The PMI ACP and PMP certifications were equally desired this year which shows that for project managers Agile and standard PM methodolgies are both utilized. Interest in Disciplined Agile has declined significantly from last year.



Not surprisingly for a Project Management organization, the Project Management Professional (PMP) remains the leading certification, followed by the miscellaneous Certified Scrum Master (CSM) category. These two categories were trailed by various Agile certifications showing that most respondents do **not currently possess** the Agile certifications.

Respondents have largely expressed no desire to teach. This remains as it was over the last two years. This may be related to decreased available time due to demands from the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
