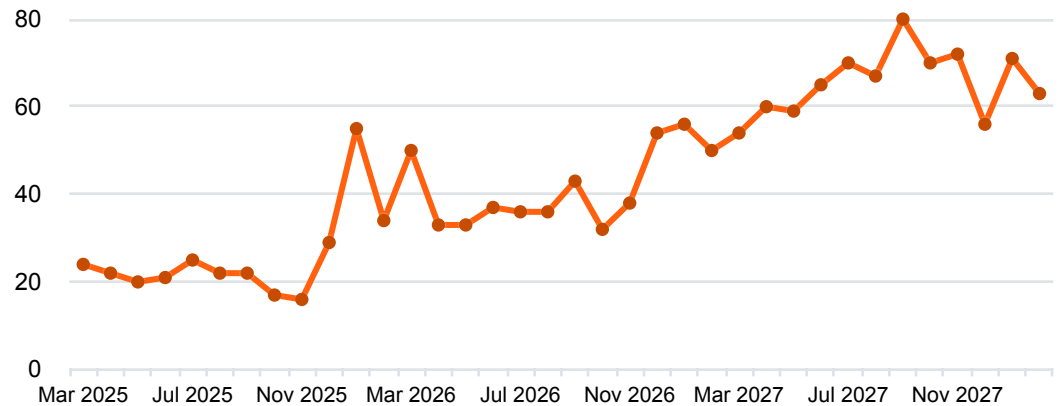

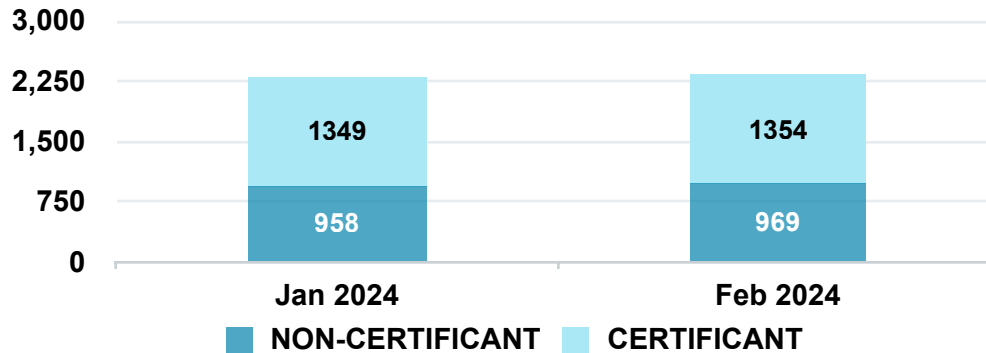
Credentials Breakdown



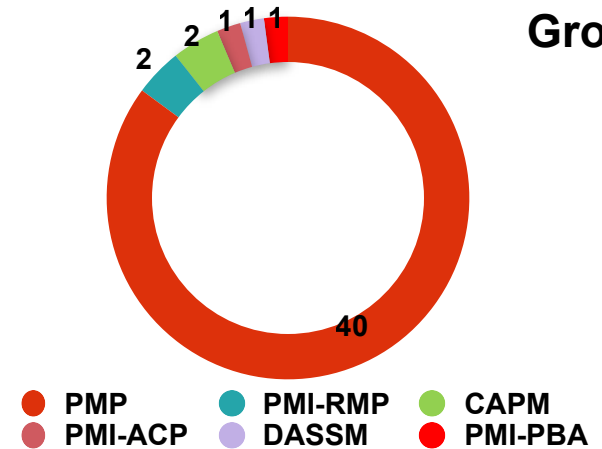

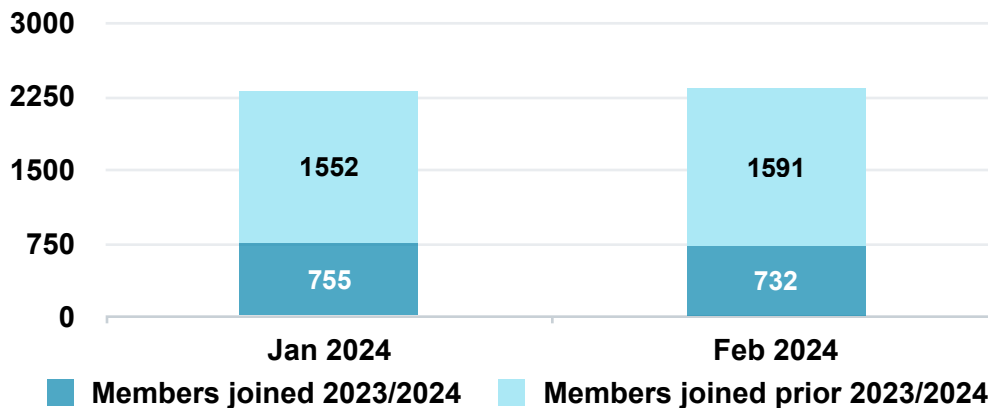
Membership Count



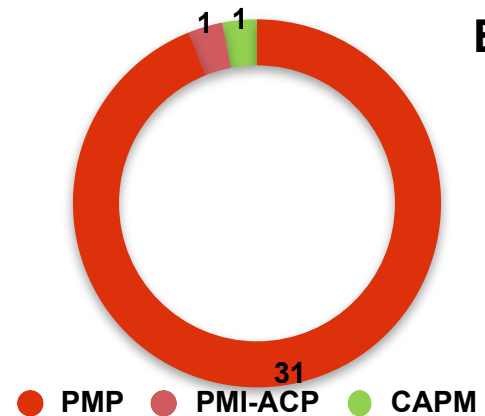
Credential Growth
